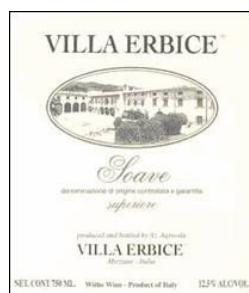


Villa Erbice
Soave Superiore

Produced from Garganega and Trebbiano grapes, this classic Italian white shows intriguing floral aromas of honeydew melon and almond, with a medium-bodied mouthfeel revealing flavors of apple and roasted nuts. Because of its softness, it is extremely versatile, suitable for drinking either before meals or with light to medium dishes.

The Erbice family's "Azienda Agricola" (winery/farm) lies in the valley of Mezzane di Sotto not far from Verona. Headed now by the brothers Silvio and Alberto Erbice, the family's vineyards have been the source of a thriving, quality-conscious business for 3 generations. Consistent with tradition, the brothers still reside in the family's eighteenth century villa directly overseeing a 30 acre vineyard, with one brother tending to the vines, while the other manages production and vinification.
